Background

- To improve the Internet speed, reliability and to consistently deliver high speed capacity;
 - To provide resiliency via complete redundancy network; and
 - To promote efficiency and affordability for use of Internet for the people.

Regulation 5(1)

 Upon the publication of the notification, the Commission may invite all licensees to register their interest to be a universal service provider in a particular universal service target


Regulation 19(2A)

 The payment shall be computed as avoidable cost (capital cost only) less any advance payment

Requirements (pg.9)



General Design Philosophy

- Primary telecommunication backbone link
- To ensure the objectives are to be met

Technical Requirements

- To design effective domestic communications system
- To ensure interconnection and comply with ITU standards

Service Requirements

- To facilitate and encourage open and fair access to bandwidth services
- MCMC reserves the right to control the bandwidth rate structure

Financial Requirements

- PPP concept
- USP Fund for Capex for 3years
- The Licensees shall ensure the operation is up to 20 years

Scope of Work (pg.11)



- Design, supply, delivery, installation, testing, commissioning and operation of SKR1M
- Laying of submarine cable system connecting Peninsular, Sarawak and Sabah
- Establishment of 6 cable landing stations, equipped with necessary equipment and related interconnection and access to other existing networks
- To operate and maintain the system for 20 years (system life period)

Design

- Responsible for overall system design
- To perform site surveys, desktop and environmental impact study

Supply and Laying Cable

- Supply all wet and dry plant equipment
- Ensure best route for laying cable
- Obtain permits and approval

Installation, testing, commissioning

- Marine and land cable installation
- Functionality and integration test
- Network Management System (NMS)

Registration of Interest Requirements (pg.13)



Must be holder of:

- 1. Network Facilities Provider (Individual) licence (NFP(I)) including fixed links and cables, and submarine cable landing centre (SCLC);
- 2. Network Services Provider (Individual) licence (NSP(I);

> NFP(I) & NSP(I) Licensees must ensure that the licensed area permitted in their licences is within the USTs that is bid for. The coverage area shall be Malaysia.

Others:

- ➤ No outstanding amount as of 14 August 2014:
 - USP Fund contribution;
 - License Fees (under CMA license); and
 - AA Fees / Any other amount due to MCMC.

MCMC reserves the right to disqualify the ROI and submission due to the above

OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE SUPPORT SERVICES

The universal service provider shall responsible to provide maintenance and operational support for a period of 20 years from the date of completion of work.

The maintenance support shall include but is not limited to preventive and corrective maintenance, trouble-shooting faults, hardware replacement inclusive of spare parts, cable cut and repairs, software update and upgrade.

The draft universal service plan shall contain detailed information on the maintenance and support services for the SKR1M including, but not limited to, the following:

- (a) Routine inspections and maintenance of the cable;
- Ensuring the availability of bandwidth as per the industry standard Service Level Agreement (SLA) commitment;
- (c) Setting up, operation and maintenance of a Network Operating Centre (NOC) by 24x7 basis;
- (d) Maintaining a log of all the defects/fault in the cable system including the down time details:
- (e) The severity shall be assigned and resolved within the time frame indicated in the SLA: and
- (f) Establishment of a 24x7 basis customer service (helpdesk) in Malaysia and to provide MCMC its contact number, contact personnel and all other relevant information for maintenance support purpose.


