PUBLIC CONSULTATION ON THE PROPOSED WAY FORWARD ON 100% ADOPTION OF AND COMPLETE MIGRATION TO INTERNET PROTOCOL VERSION 6 (IPv6) IN MALAYSIA

- Submission of feedback by 31 October 2024 (12:00 noon, Thursday)

CYBERJAYA, 2 October 2024 – The Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission (MCMC) is undertaking a Public Consultation on the proposed way forward for 100% adoption of and complete migration to IPv6 in Malaysia, from 2 October 2024 to 31 October 2024.

The transition from Internet Protocol Version 4 (IPv4) to IPv6 represents a significant advancement of the Internet as it addresses the limitations and depletion of IPv4 due to the exponential increase in connected devices, with the ultimate goal to achieve an IPv6-only state.

Considering the above, it is essential that a defined timeframe is established to expedite the full adoption and migration to IPv6. A phased implementation plan targeting a complete transition over a four-year period from 2025 to 2028 is proposed to be incorporated as a way forward for this exercise.

MCMC invites written feedback and views from the industry, interested parties, and members of the public on the proposed way forward for 100% adoption of and complete migration to IPv6 in Malaysia. Such feedback and views are to be submitted to:
